Family Assistance Specialists (FAS):

There are four FAS in Arizona. They provide crisis intervention, legal resource information, financial resources and referrals, TriCare information, ID card/DEERs information, and community resources and referrals. Your FAS is your first stop/go-to person for all situations where a soldier needs help in some way. Give them a call, explain the need and they WILL get you connected to resources. The FAS closest to the 301st MI BN is right there at Papago. Contact information for each FAS and their region is on the second page of this document.

If you have soldiers facing **immediate homelessness and are in dire situations**, Papago Military Reservation can allow for soldiers to have free temporary lodging in their barracks. Some stipulations apply – no children/other family members would be able to stay there for safety reasons – but it is a good option to explore if one of your soldiers needs a temporary roof over their head. Your POC for this is SSG McWhorter. His number is 602-629-4354.

Military Assistance Mission (MAM): Provides two types of financial assistance to active duty & reserve military personnel rank E6 or below and another for Wounded Warriors post 9/11. If you are M-DAY, Drilling Reservist, or Weekend Warrior, they have limited temporary funding to assist you at this time, pending approval. Use the "Active Duty" application. Financial assistance is given on a one-time basis. Required Docs: LES, Military ID, Current orders, pay statements, and all bills.
